RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HER DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS A&M FOREST SERVICE TO FACILITATE THE DONATION OF END-OF-SERVICE-LIFE FIRE EQUIPMENT TO THE HELPING HANDS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, for the safety of the firefighters, the Lewisville Fire Department periodically retires fire equipment which has reached the end of its service life; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 88.106 of the Texas Education Code and Article III, Section 52i of the Texas Constitution, the City is authorized to donate end-of-service-life fire equipment to the Texas A&M Forest Service for the service's use or the service's distribution to volunteer fire departments through the Helping Hands program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Government Code, Chapter 791, known as the Interlocal Cooperation Act, the City Council wishes to enter into an interlocal agreement with the Texas A&M Forest Service for donation of end-of-service-life fire equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The recitations and findings contained in the preamble of this resolution are incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. The Lewisville City Council authorizes the City Manager or her designee to execute the five-year interlocal agreement with the Texas A&M Forest Service for the donation of end-of-service-life fire equipment, attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.
